- *e.* Conversation: Ability to converse in Mandarin on subject matters covered in Chinese 1 lesson.
- f. Orthography: ability to recognize correctly 150 Chinese characters, and to write accurately 100 characters with correct stroke order from memory.
- g. Environmental Awareness: Ability to aware the current issue related to the language lesson and topic.
